After a brief introduction and training, we will split up into teams to clean as many markers as possible, in the town of Schuyler Falls. (There are 20!)

Supplies provided, including soap, water, buckets, gloves, portable sprayers, sponges, non-metal scrub brushes, toothbrushes, cloth rags and trash bags. Participants are encouraged to bring similar supplies, if possible, as well as protective eye gear, small step ladder, and grass clippers. Dress for the weather!
