ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for the furnishing of all labor and material necessary for the Town of Schuyler Falls Highway Garage Floor Replacement Project will be received by the Town of Schuyler Falls Clerk, 997 Mason Street, Morrisonville, NY 12962 until 11:00 A.M. local time Tuesday, May 23, 2023. They will be opened and publicly read aloud at 6:00 P.M. local time Tuesday, May 23, 2023 at the start of the Town Board meeting. Bids shall be addressed to Donna A Hamel, Town Clerk, 997 Mason Street, Morrisonville, NY 12962. Bids shall be in sealed envelopes which shall bear, on the face thereof, the name and address of the Bidder and subject of the Bid.

Bids will be received for the following Contract:

Contract No. 1A – General Construction: The work shall include providing all labor, materials and equipment, and other means of construction necessary and incidental to the saw-cut and removal of areas of the existing building concrete slab, and replacement including new trench and pipe drainage, and installation of 3,000 gallon below grade storage tank and associated electrical alarm system.

Contract Documents, including Advertisement For Bids, Information For Bidders, Labor and Employment, Additional Instructions, Bid Documents, Agreement, General Conditions, General Requirements, Specifications, Contract Drawings and any Addenda, may be obtained from Barton & Loguidice, D.P.C., by providing contact information to jfelber@bartonandloguidice.com. Download instructions will be provided upon notification.

Each bid must be accompanied by security in an amount not less than five percentum (5%) of the amount of the Bid in the form and subject to the conditions provided in the Information for Bidders. No Bidder may withdraw his bid within forty-five (45) days after the actual date of opening thereof.

This is an exempt capital improvement project, and Bidders shall not include in their bid sales and compensating use taxes on the cost of materials which are to be incorporated into the work and which are to be separately sold by the Contractor to the Town of Schuyler Falls prior to incorporation into the work of the Contract.

In accordance with New York State General Municipal Law Section 101 (a.k.a. “Wicks Law”), all Bidders must include with their Bid a separately sealed list naming each Subcontractor for plumbing, HVAC and electrical work along with the amount to be paid to each.

The attention of Bidders is particularly called to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to be paid under the Contract.

The right is reserved to waive any informalities in the Bid and to reject any or all Bids.
